Chancellor Mark Mone

- A. Today there is the biennial meeting with the UW System representatives for capital project planning. The campus priorities are (1) the Northwest Quad remodeling, (2) a new building for Engineering and Neurosciences, and (3) financing for the Zilber SPH building.
- B. Meetings with individual Regents on capital projects and the reallocation of GPR funding continue.
- C. Next week's Town Hall will focus on acknowledging the need to improve employee morale and mental health and the actions that are ongoing on campus to meet those goals.
- D. There was discussion on faculty service and the need to have campus-level and college-level administration indicate that faculty service is important and should be rewarded.

Professor Lane Hall

A. There was a discussion on the Fiscal Misconduct Training held for chairs last week, and the appearance of the campus shifting responsibility for monitoring misconduct to faculty and staff. Displeasure was expressed over the emphasis on small-scale fraud, with little discussion of large-scale issues. Concerns were also
