



2023 UWM Distinguished Undergraduate Teaching Award

UWM recognizes outstanding undergraduate teachers by granting the Distinguished Undergraduate Teaching Award. Awards carrying a \$1,500 honorarium are granted each year. Nominations for Awards may be submitted by students, faculty, academic staff, departments, and organizations.

ELIGIBLE NOMINEES MUST:

Be an Assistant Professor, Associate Professor, or Professor at UWM*

Demonstrate excellence in classroom teaching

Teach an undergraduate course in either Fall or Spring semesters, 2022-2023

Have worked at UWM full time for at least three academic years

*UWM includes: UW-Milwaukee, UWM at Washington County and UWM at Waukesha

TO NOMINATE SOMEONE FOR THE AWARD:

Send one (1) copy of a letter of nomination, describing why the nominee merits the award (e.g., command of subject, classroom organization, teaching innovations, stimulation of learning, awareness of student needs) to the address below. Nomination letters may be no longer than three pages. Please include the nominee's CV, a summary of student evaluations, and a teaching schedule. Following the nomination, the Awards and Recognitions Committee may request additional material from the candidate, meet with the candidate, and/or attend (physically or virtually) at least one of the nominee's classes.
