Panther Athletics: Academic Excellence

- Graduation Success Rate : 91%
- Federal Graduation Rate: 73%
- Academic Progress Rate: 982
- Consecutive semesters overall GPA of 3.0 or higher: 45
- Consecutive semesters overall GPA of 3.2 or higher: 16

- 32 Horizon League team championships
- 10 NCAA Tournament appearances
- 51 Horizon League team runners-up
- 104 Horizon League top-three team finishes

Historical Success:

- 325 student-athletes collectively pay over \$4 million annually to attend UWM


