No more than two members shall be from a single college. No more than one member shall be from a single department in a departmentalized school or college. Nominations and elections for the faculty members will take place at the May Faculty Senate meeting. The chair shall be a faculty member elected by the committee.

2. Election of the 2023-2024 Faculty Senate Rules Committee. (Nominations and balloting at this meeting). "Seven members as follows: Six members of the Senate elected annually by the Senate, at least one member shall be from each faculty division, and the Chancellor, ex-officio.

The chairperson is elected from among the members of the committee by majority vote of the Senate and becomes President pro tem of the Senate, who also serves as a member of the University Committee. Any given college may not be represented in consecutive years in the chair of the Rules Committee; further, membership composition restrictions of the University Committee with respect to college and departmental affiliation of its members shall also be followed when electing the chairperson."

Faculty from the College of Engineering \& Applied Science and College of Letters \& Science are not eligible for chairperson. The 2023-2024 Senate membership roster is attached. Please obtain consent of the person(s) you nominate. (Not later than 3:15 p.m.)
