- II. Amanda introduced Chris Roche, Associate Director of Athletics-Development and Cody Bohl, Assistant Director of Athletics-Development and Panthers Unite. Created Cody's position from vacant positions, moved Cody from communications to this position. He reports to Cathy Rossi, Chris reports to central development.

 - i. Will be a Friday launch for athletics, campus launches on Thursday.
 - ii. 2020 \$6,300; 43 donors. (2020 was NOT a university wide initiative but we did it internally as a competition with the teams).
 - iii. 2021 \$41,858; 215 donors
 - iv. 2022 \$63,835 from 161 donors.
