- a. ProQuest electronic thesis submission (Discussion)
  - i. John Berges described the theses policy, Fac. Doc. 3201R1: 201/1262: Policy and Time Limit for Temporary Withholding of Theses and Dissertations from Public Disclosure, and summarized the discussions held with campus stakeholders about the current process and procedure.
