Study comparative social work and criminal justice policy and practice at Upper Austria University in Linz, Austria. The program concentrates on social work and criminal justice, with special emphasis placed on the role of integration of differing cultures, especially immigrant groups, into society. Students will attend an international conference the first week with students from many schools in Europe. During the second week, students will attend a number of site visits (police departments, homes for asylum seekers, domestic violence agencies) and talk with professionals in social work and criminal justice. Tuition, lodging, many meals, and ground transportation included in course fee.
