

# STUDY ABROAD IN SPANISH-SPEAKING COUNTRIES!

If you are a Spanish major or minor or plan to teach Spanish, you will want to supplement your academic work at UWM with a study abroad experience in a Spanish-speaking country. UWM's Center for International Education (CIE) study abroad office has several semester and year-long Spanish-language program options that may be of interest to majors, minors or students in a wide variety of majors. UWM-sponsored programs offer UWM credit or you may choose an affiliate or non-UWM program for which you can earn transfer credits.

## **SCHOLARSHIP MONEY IS AVAILABLE FOR STUDY ABROAD!**

**The Wisconsin Study Abroad Grant** provides up to \$2000 for a semester or academic year for full-time, Wisconsin-resident, undergraduate UWM students attending a UWM-sponsored study abroad program. The Wisconsin Grant is also available for students doing summer or UWinterim programs, awarding up to \$1000. **Type of Program:** Study Abroad Program

**Length of Program:** Fall or Spring semester or Academic Year (March to Dec.) 12-18 semester credits (U)

**Course Subjects:** Humanities, Social Science, Economics, Business, Fine Arts, and Natural Science

**Language of Instruction:** Spanish (requires minimum 4 semesters of college-level Spanish or equivalent)

**Housing:** homestays

### **PERU**

**University:** Pontificia Universidad Católica del Perú, Lima

**Type of Program:** Exchange Program

**Length of Program:** Fall or Spring semester, Academic Year, 12-18 semester credits (U), 8-12 semester credits (G)

**Course Subjects:** Humanities, Education, Architecture, Sciences, Political Science, Fine Arts, Graphic Design, Social Work, Archaeology, Linguistics, and Information Sciences

**Language of Instruction:** Spanish (requires minimum 6 semesters of college-level Spanish or equivalent)

**Housing:** homestays, off-campus student residences

### **MEXICO**

**University:** Tecnológico de Monterrey – 9 different campuses

**Type of Program:** Exchange program

**Length of Program:** Fall or Spring semester, Academic Year, or Summer, 12-18 semester credits (U), 8-12 semester credits (G)

**Course Subjects:** Language, Culture, Literature, Business, Tourism, Economics, Art. Internships available (U/G)

**Language of Instruction:** Spanish (requires minimum 4 semesters of college-level Spanish or equivalent; minimum 2 semesters for summer program)

**Housing:** (varies by campus) residence halls, off-campus apartments or homestays

**University:** Universidad de Santiago de Compostela

**Type of Program:** Exchange Program

**Length of Program:** Spring semester or Academic year, 12-18 semester credits (U) 8-12 semester credits (G)

**Course Subjects:** Health Sciences, Business, Spanish language, Natural Sciences, Humanities, Galician Studies (U/G)

**Language of Instruction:** Spanish (requires minimum 5 semesters of college-level Spanish or equivalent)

**Housing:** apartments, student residences (academic year only)

**University:** Universidad de Vigo

**Type of Program:** Exchange Program

**Length of Program:** Spring semester or Academic year, 12-18 semester credits (U) 8-12 semester credits (G)

**Course Subjects:** Engineering, Business, Spanish language, Law, Galician Studies (U/G)

**Language of Instruction:** Spanish (requires minimum 5 semesters of college-level Spanish or equivalent)

**Housing:** apartments
