 - ii. Debate event will be for registered political student orgs

- iii. John already drafted a proposal and has the funding for the debate
- iv. SLC would help with logistics and marketing
 - v. Official event: 12/5/18 at 7pm in the Wisconsin Room.
- vi. SLC would also help determine what questions will go on the application form for the debate
- vii. Current ideas for form questions
 - 1. Questions could aim to glean how much knowledge student orgs have on the issues (i.e. education policy) or the professionalism of the orgs and their members
- viii. Potential questions/topics
 - 1. Campus safety
 - 2. Funding for the Chemistry Building
 - 3. Segregated fees
 - 4. Shared governance

- ix. Josh proposes we set the greater topic of education and break it down into the following categories

 - 1. Committee feels that, because the event is featuring student orgs, we should shape our topics and the structure of the debate around their goals for this event
 - 2. The committee feels comfortable with John sending out the invite providing logistical information
- xi. Need to then find a (Poli Sci) professor to support/moderate
 - 1. Stuart might know a professor to reach out to
- xii. Go to SA to ask for funds from the programming budget
- xiii. We want to have the debate after the midterm elections to avoid our conversations being dominated by what political candidates are saying
- b. Yugg (International Student Advocacy Senator)
 - i. Working with John McCune to have an event with the theme of party around the world featuring diverse student orgs
 - ii. Goal will be to have 5 orgs come together to represent their culture as well as to offer international students a greater sense of belonging at UWM
 - iii. We could even go on to do this on a regular basis
 - iv. About 100 people expected to attend, total cost will be about \$1800
 - v. The committee is supportive of this

 - i. We will make the listserv grouping together several orgs based on their type
