School and College Update- Constitutional Amendment

1 **WHEREAS**, the University of Wisconsin- Milwaukee has decided to realign the schools and colleges to
2 better fit students and administration through the 2030 plan.

3 **WHEREAS**, the schools and colleges will now be organized into ten schools effective July 1st, 2023 in
4 which the organization will now be; the College of the Arts & Architecture, the College of Community
5 Engagement & Professions, the College of Engineering & Applied Science, the School of Freshwater
6 Sciences, the College of General Studies, the College of Health Professions & Sciences, the Joseph J.
7 Zilber College of Public Health, the College of Letters & Science, the Graduate School, and the Lubar
8 College of Business.

9 **WHEREAS**, Amendment 1718-07, line 26 through 28, in which Article IV, section 4.01, subsection b,
10 subsection iii (b) was amended now requires a secondary update.


11 **WHEREAS**, Amendment 1718-07, line 37 through 39, in which Article IV, section 4.01, subsection b,
12 subsection vii was amended now requires a secondary update.

13 **THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**; The Student Association at the University of Wisconsin-Milwaukee senate
14 recommends the following changes to the constitution be forwarded to the Independent Elections
15 Commission to be put forth for a constitutional referendum in a timeline such that, contingent on
16 passage of the referendum, the amendments will take effect on May 1st of 2023.

17 **THEREFORE, BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**; amend Article IV, Section 4.01, subsection b, to read, "The
18 Senate shall be composed of 38 senators, who meet the eligibility requirements outlined in Article II,
19 Section 2.02, (a), (l), and shall have the following distribution:"

20 **THEREFORE, BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**; amend Article IV, Section 4.01, subsection b, subsection vii
21 (c) to read, "The remaining 6 seats shall be designated for students from each of the remaining colleges
22 and the School of Freshwater Sciences, with each receiving one seat."

23 **THEREFORE, BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED**; these constitutional amendments shall be submitted to the
24 Independent Election Commission, to the Chair of the Oversight and Appeals Commission, to the Dean
25 of Students, the Vice Chancellor of Student Affairs, and to the Student Association Professional Staff.
