### **FAFSA**

Don't forget to complete your 2025–2026 <u>Free Application for Federal Student Aid!</u> It's important to check that you are completing an application for the 2025–2026 academic year. You will also want to ensure that you have your FAFSA sent to UW-Milwaukee along with any other schools you are looking at.





### **WISCONSIN GI BILL**

## AID PACKAGE AND SCHOLARSHIPS

If you are eligible and have completed the FAFSA already, financial aid packages have been applied to your PAWS account. Log into your <u>PAWS</u> account to see any scholarships/merit-based awards. Be sure to continue to apply for scholarships through UWM, your high school, or local community. ## HOUSING

If you are deciding to live within a residence hall at UWM, there is a \$50 housing fee that cannot be pushed off like the New Student Orientation fee. This means that you will need to pay that amount when you submit your housing contract/info.

When you register for New Student Orientation at UWM you will see that there is a payment due for \$250. This is not due at the time of registration – it will not be assessed until the first day of classes.
