What is the Future Success Program?

The Future Success Program (FSP) provides academic support services to students and parents in preparation for college admission, enrollment and completion. Students eligible for free or reduced lunch in grades 9-12 with a GPA of at least a 2.0 will be ensured completion of college prep coursework, ACT Prep, assistance with college and financial aid applications and scholarship forms. Students will be provided intense academic advising, career exploration, mentoring, tutoring and study skills workshops.

Academic Year Program

The academic year component runs from Oct-May and consists of critical thinking workshops, tutoring, academic advising, ACT Prep Course and exam, college exploration, career exploration, college campus visits local/national, mentoring and parental informational sessions. Students will also take part in UWM workshops that focus on the 4 Year High School Graduation Plan and Test Taking Techniques.

Summer Program

The summer component is designed to be an instructional program for students to be better prepared for their core classes the following school year and to offer college level coursework.

During the 5 intensive weeks the goal is to improve study skills, offer tutoring and academic advising. The core curriculum consists of areas in Math, Science and English. STEM electives in Health, IT, Architecture and Engineering as well as career electives in Business and Spanish are offered.

All students commute daily to the UWM campus and are provided bus tickets and lunch.
