

PROGRAM DESCRIPTION

Veterans Upward Bound (VUB) is a federally funded TRIO Program (U.S. Department of Education) designed to help qualified military veterans become college-ready and enroll in a postsecondary school (university, community college, and vocational/technical programs). VUB provides basic skills instruction and educational and career advising to enable veterans to achieve their academic goals.

The primary goal of VUB at UWM is to help veterans reach their full academic potential. All services are FREE to eligible veterans.

WHO IS ELIGIBLE

Any peace or wartime veteran discharged under conditions other than dishonorable after serving at least six months of active duty (other than for training only) is eligible. The veteran must also meet low income, first generation college student status and/or have an academic need.





HOW IT WORKS

- Take an assessment test to determine where you are academically.
- Meet one-on-one with our advisor or director to discuss your interests and goals and develop a plan.
- Attend our classes, tutoring, or work independently with our software programs to strengthen any academic weaknesses.
- Receive help with the college admissions process.

Upon completion of the VUB program we will continue to be a resource for your ongoing educational success.

Over 1,800 veterans have graduated from colleges all over the country with the help of VUB programs.



VUB provides free classes to eligible veterans in Milwaukee and Racine Counties and online programs are available for outlying counties.
