

Audience Behavior Guidelines

UWM Union

The University of Wisconsin-Milwaukee embraces the principles of free speech and the resulting free exchange of ideas. To assure that the speaker can be heard and the audience can hear and see, the following guidelines have been set by the UWM Union Administration in accordance with the Wisconsin Administrative Code:

- 1. PROTESTERS MUST NOT OBSTRUCT NORMAL TRAFFIC FLOW**
All aisles, exits and passageways must be kept clear.
- 2. NO STICKS OR STANDARDS**
No signs supported by sticks or standards shall be permitted in any assembly in a University building.
- 3. VERBAL/SOUND DEMONSTRATION LIMITATIONS**
Noise levels that impede the program's progress or the audience's ability to hear will not be tolerated.
- 4. OBJECTS MAY NOT BE THROWN**
The throwing of hard objects will not be tolerated.
- 5. FORCE OR VIOLENCE NOTIFICATION**
Behavior that infringes on the safety of others or endangers University property will not be tolerated.

An individual or group of individuals who violate these guidelines of the Wisconsin Administrative Code may be subject to removal and/or arrest.
