

UWM Voter ID Enrollment Letter – Mailing Address Update

Step 1 - Login to PAWS at paws.uwm.edu

Step 2 - Check that your mailing address is your current address under User Preferences

Students who need to provide proof of their enrollment at UW-Milwaukee and/or present a piece of communication from a government agency verifying their current local address can generate and print a Voter ID Enrollment Letter. Prior to clicking on the link below to generate your letter, please update your PAWS Mailing Address to reflect your current/local address. Students living in UWM residence facilities should update their PAWS Mailing Address as follows:
